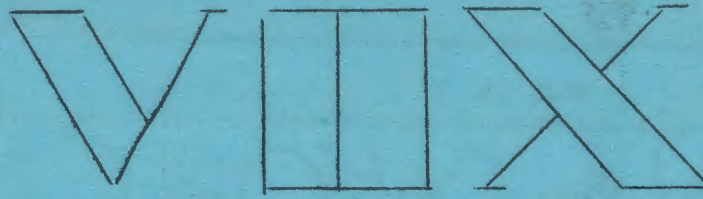

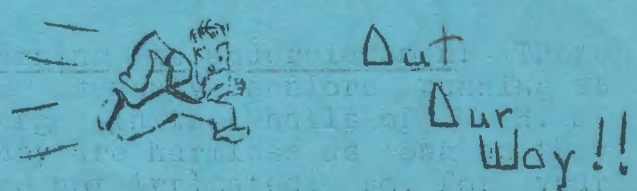
Senior Calendar

This calendar of senior activities only partly explains why they're always hurrying.

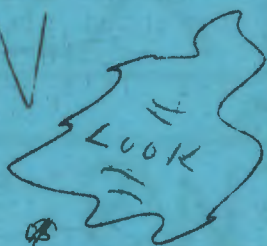

It seems that Eileen S. made quite a hit at Jr. Academy convention. At least she had visitors Saturday night.

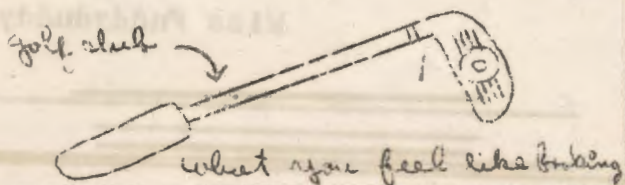
Marilyn didn't have as much fun this year cause "Axe-head" was at music contest.

JUNIOR HIGH GOSSIP

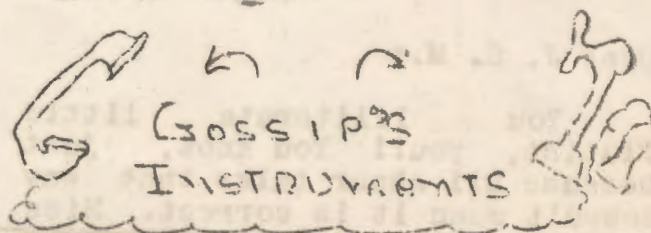
Loyce Schenken and Gaylon Caylor seem to have broken up. Gardener wouldn't have anything to do with it, would he?

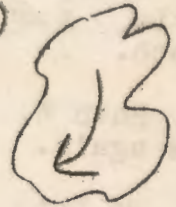

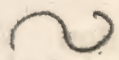
